## A BILL

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Claiming Age Clarity
- 5 Act".

#### 1 SEC. 2. CHANGES TO SOCIAL SECURITY TERMINOLOGY.

2 Not later than January 1, 2027, the Commissioner 3 of Social Security shall ensure that, in any rules, regula-4 tion, guidance, or other materials of the Social Security 5 Administration, whether online or in print— (1) the term "early eligibility age" is replaced 6 7 with the term "minimum monthly benefit age"; (2) the terms "full retirement age" and "nor-8 mal retirement age" are replaced with the term 9 "standard monthly benefit age"; and 10 11 (3) the term "delayed retirement credit" shall 12 not be used and any reference to age 70 as the max-13 imum age up to which delayed retirement credits 14 can be received shall be replaced with the term "maximum monthly benefit age". 15
