3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Claiming Age Clarity
5 Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. CHANGES TO SOCIAL SECURITY TERMINOLOGY.**

2 Not later than January 1, 2027, the Commissioner
3 of Social Security shall ensure that, in any rules, regula-
4 tion, guidance, or other materials of the Social Security
5 Administration, whether online or in print—

6 (1) the term “early eligibility age” is replaced
7 with the term “minimum monthly benefit age”;

8 (2) the terms “full retirement age” and “nor-
9 mal retirement age” are replaced with the term
10 “standard monthly benefit age”; and

11 (3) the term “delayed retirement credit” shall
12 not be used and any reference to age 70 as the max-
13 imum age up to which delayed retirement credits
14 can be received shall be replaced with the term
15 “maximum monthly benefit age”.
